

Parade Rules and Information

Parade Entry Forms must be received by **Wednesday, May 6, 2026** in order to be put in the Parade Route. Any Entry Forms received after this date will be placed in line at the end of the parade.

Registration begins at 8:00 A.M. on May 9, 2026 at the corner of East Calvert and North Manse Street, ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST CHECK IN!

Parade begins PROMPTLY at 10:30 A.M., rain or shine. Drivers and participants must be ready to begin moving by 10:00 A.M. Bring rain gear or plastic covering if needed, as these items will not be provided.

1. Judging is on Saturday, May 9, 2026, promptly at 9:15 A.M. All entries must be in place, set-up, and riders must be on entry until all judging is completed. Entries will not be judged if participants are NOT IN PLACE. PARTICIPATION COUNTS!

2. Automobiles and Large Vehicles must be driven by a licensed driver.

3. EXCESSIVE DRINKING, LOUD OR VULGAR REMARKS, AND PROFANITY WILL NOT BE TOLERATED FROM PARADE PARTICIPANTS! This is a family event and all drivers, float riders, and participants are expected to behave in an appropriate and tasteful manner. Floats and entries must also be in good taste and considered appropriate for spectators. Any violations of this will result in the removal of the entry. If you have any questions about what is deemed appropriate, please, contact the parade director.

4. The Lee County Fair Association, the Fair Parade Director and/or Committee members assume **NO** responsibility for accidents or loss of any kind.

5. No blow pops, suckers, pencils, pens, or any item with stick pins may be thrown from entries.
