Age Divisions:

Miss Lee County – Eligibility is limited to High School Freshman through High School Junior as of August 2024

Junior Miss Lee County – Eligibility is limited to 6th through 8th Grade as of August 2024

Little Miss Lee County - Eligibility is limited to 3rd through 5th Grade as of August 2024

Petite Miss Lee County - Eligibility is limited to Kindergarten through 2nd Grade as of August 2024

Tiny Miss Lee County – Eligibility is limited to 3 years of Age through Pre-K as of August 2024

Tiny Mr. Lee County – Eligibility is limited to 3 years of Age through Pre-K as of August 2024

Little Mr Lee County – Eligibility is limited to Kindergarten – 3rd grade as of August 2024

Judges will be judging on personality, Enthusiasm, and overall appearance.

Appear on stage for judging in an evening gown of their choice for Miss that is age appropriate. All gowns should compliment the delegate and fit well. Petite/Little/Junior may wear a Sunday Dress or pageant dress of their choice.

Judges scoring on grace, poise, and elegance, and beauty.

Tiny Mr. and Little Mr. may wear suit or western shirt, jeans and boots.

Interview: Express yourself through communicating effectively with the judges and show your personality in an approx 90 second session with the panel of judges answering simple questions From your Application. Judges scoring on a confident speaker for age and enthusiasm in Speaking skills.

2025 Lee County Fair Queen Pageant Rules

-Contestants participating in the Miss Lee County Fair Queen/King Pageant must either attend a Lee County School or reside in Lee County as of January 2024

-Fair Queen/King Candidates must be (and always have been) female/Male as recorded on their birth certificate.

-Fair Queen/King Candidates may never have been married or have had children or be pregnant at the time of the Lee County Fair. If the Fair Queen becomes pregnant or is married during her reign, she will be required to relinquish her title and her scholarship and will immediately cease and desist her representation as Fair Queen. The remainder of the Fair Queen's scholarship will pass to the 1st Runner Up.

-Fair Queen/King Candidates and the Fair Queen must not have been charged with or convicted of any criminal offense. This includes but is not limited to misdemeanors (such as minor-in-possession, driving under the influence, criminal mischief, destruction of property, etc.; apart from minor traffic violations). Additionally, there must be no adjudications presently pending against the candidate.

Any individual having been crowned Lee County Fair Queen/King is not eligible to be a Fair Queen/King Candidate again till the following year.

Fair Queen/King Candidates or Fair Queen MAY NOT use alcohol, any form of illegal drugs, smoke, vapor, or use tobacco in any form. Zero tolerance policy will be enforced and should the situation arise, the candidate will be notified immediately and may result in the candidate being disqualified.

Fair Queen/King Candidates must agree to be personally interviewed by the judges and understand that the decision of the judging panel is final. Judges' scoresheets will remain confidential and become property of the Lee County Fair Queen Board.

Fair Queen/King Candidates must be of good moral character. If any candidate or Fair Queen is deemed to participate in inappropriate comments, immoral or indecent acts or behavior in any way, including but not limited to on social media (Facebook, Twitter, and the like) that candidate will be ineligible for the contest. If any Fair Queen/King Candidate is found to have engaged in any immoral or indecent acts, the Fair Queen/King Candidates may be found ineligible.

Any Fair Queen/King Candidate or Fair Queen shall abstain from public displays of affection toward their boyfriend/girlfriend or significant other during the Fair week and while participating at any Fair function throughout the year.

Hair and make-up for the pageant should be age appropriate.

Contestants must attend all practices, pre-pageant events and rehearsals unless excused, in advance by the Pageant Directors.

Any official reports of misconduct or unsportsmanlike behavior of a contestant or parent may The newly selected Miss Lee County Fair Queen/King and all the winning courts will serve along with the Petite, Little and Junior Miss Queens/King and courts at the Lee County Fair 2025

All newly selected Courts of Lee County Fair are required to attend the Lee County Fair 2025, distributing ribbons and other duties designated by the Pageant Directors or any member of the Fair Board. Queens/Kings must be available the whole weekend to assist.

Attendance at local and surrounding parades is highly encouraged at the approval of the pageant director. It is the responsibility of the Lee County parent/guardian to provide all transportation to and from any event, and during the event.

The contestant will not be officially entered in the Lee County Pageant until the finished application is submitted to the Pageant Director. The finished application must be submitted by the deadline.

In the event of a natural disaster or other unavoidable events, the Lee County Fair Pageant Committee may change the dates and times of the contest, parade, coronation, and other activities associated with the Lee County Fair Queens/King Scholarship Contest. It is the responsibility of the Fair Queen/King Candidate to provide the Queens Committee with at least 1 valid telephone numbers, a mailing address, and appropriate email addresses at which they can be reached, as well as valid contact information for the Fair Queen Candidate's legal guardian. It is the responsibility of the Fair Queen Candidate to remain in contact with the Director(s) in Charge to obtain any changes in locations, obligations, dates, times, and rules. Fair Queen/King winners will be issued a sash and crown at the coronation and will be responsible if the items are lost or damaged. Replacement will be the queens responsibility and must be ordered immediately

The Fair Queen/King Candidate selected as Fair Queen/King must sign a contract with the Lee County Fair Queen/King Committee immediately following her coronation.

The Lee County Fair Queen/King will serve a term of one year as an ambassador of the Lee County Fair. The Fair Queen/King is also expected to attend other Fair-sponsored events throughout the year, a list

of which will be provided. The Fair Queen/King will also serve on the Lee County Fair Association Queen/King Committee for the following year.
Please sign and bring this to the first practice with 2 5x7 photos of your choice. The photos will not be returned to the contestant and become property of the Fair.

The Tiny, Petite, Little, Junior and Miss/Mr Lee County Fair Pageant are for the contestant and new queen/King and their court. All parents or guardians (referred to hereby as parent) associated with the Tiny, Petite, Little, Junior and Miss/Mr Lee County Fair Pageant welcomes you to share in the pleasure

of watching your child participate as long as their behavior does not distract the contestants, Lee County Fair Board, Pageant Director, pageant crew and the judges. Any issues a parent may have with any of the above mentioned persons should be submitted in writing to the Lee County Fair Association office and addressed as a proper time and place.

The Parent Should:

- Make no remarks to the Lee County Fair Board, the Pageant Directors, pageant crew, judges or spectator's unless intended to convey a genuine interest, friendship or encouragement. Avoid sharp remarks directed to contestants who make mistakes during the Tiny, Petite, Little, Junior and Miss/Mr Lee County Fair Pageant.
- Support the Lee County Fair Board, Pageant Directors, pageant crew and judges consistently regardless of the result of the competition. The Lee County Fair Board, Pageant Director, pageant crew and judges contribute many hours of their time to your daughter.

The Parent Must:

- Never use foul language or obscene gestures at pageant events related to and including the Tiny, Petite, Little, Junior and Miss/Mr Lee County Fair Queen Pageant.
- Avoid persistent comments and gestures which express discouragement with the judge's final decisions.
- Cooperation immediately with any request by the Lee County Fair Board, and the Pageant Directors, or pageant crew.

Any parent who fails to adhere to these standards can and will be asked to leave and will run the risk of their daughter being disqualified from obtaining the title of Tiny, Petite, Little, Junior and Miss/Mr Lee County Fair Queen.
