Age Divisions

Miss/Mr Lee County – Eligibility is limited to High School Freshman through High School Juniors as of August 2025

Junior Miss/Mr Lee County - Eligibility is limited to 6th through 8th grade as of August 2025

Little Miss/Mr Lee County - Eligibility is limited to 3rd through 5th grade as of August 2025

Mini Miss/Mr Lee County - Eligibility is limited to Kindergarten through 2nd grade as of August 2025

Tiny Miss/Mr Lee County – Eligibility is limited to 3 years of Age through Pre-K as of 2025

Judging/Wardrobe

Judges will be scoring on grace, poise, elegance, and beauty.

Contestants in the Miss & Junior Miss divisions will appear on stage for judging in an evening gown of their choice that is age appropriate. Gowns should compliment the delegate and fit well.

Contestants in the Mr & Junior Mr divisions will appear on stage for judging in either a formal suit/tuxedo or in nice jeans, boots with a sportcoat. Cowboy hats may also be worn.

Tiny, Mini and Little Miss may wear a Sunday Dress or pageant dress of their choice.

Tiny, Mini and Little Mr may wear suit or western shirt, jeans and boots.

During the interview portion judges will be scoring on personality, enthusiasm in speaking skills, being a confident speaker for their age and overall appearance.

All Little, Mini and Tiny contestants will be given questions to practice at home.

Contestants should express yourself through communicating effectively with the judges and show your personality to the panel of judges by answering simple questions from your application.

2026 Lee County Fair Royalty Pageant Rules

-Contestants participating in the Miss Lee County Fair Royalty Pageant must either attend a Lee County School or reside in Lee County as of January 2026

-Fair Queen/King Candidates must be (and always have been) female/male as recorded on their birth certificate.

-Fair Queen/King Candidates may never have been married or have had children or be pregnant at the time of the Lee County Fair. If the Fair Queen becomes pregnant or is married during his/her reign they will be required to relinquish their title and scholarship and will immediately cease and desist his/her representation as Fair Queen or King. The remainder of the scholarship will pass to the 1st Runner Up.

-Fair Queen/King Candidates and the Fair Queen/King must not have been charged with or convicted of any criminal offense. This includes but is not limited to misdemeanors (such as minor-in-possession, driving under the influence, criminal mischief, destruction of property, etc.; apart from minor traffic violations

-Fair Queen/King Candidates or Fair Queen/King MAY NOT use alcohol, any form of illegal drugs, smoke, vapor, or use tobacco in any form. A zero tolerance policy will be enforced and should the situation arise, the candidate will be notified immediately and may result in the candidate being disqualified.

-Any individual having been crowned Lee County Fair Queen/King in 2025 may not compete in the same age division in 2026. If they are moving up/changing age divisions they are able to compete. Ex: If crowned in the Junior division in 2025 they may compete in the Miss/Mr division in 2026 but not again in the Junior division.

-Fair Queen/King Candidates must agree to be personally interviewed by the judges and understand that the decision of the judging panel is final. Judges' scoresheets will remain confidential and become property of the Lee County Fair Board.

-Fair Queen/King Candidates must be of good moral character. If any candidate or Fair Queen/King is deemed to have participated in inappropriate comments, immoral or indecent acts or behavior in any way, including but not limited to on social media (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, TikTok, Snapchat and the like) that candidate will be ineligible for the contest.

-Any Fair Queen/King Candidate or Fair Queen/King shall abstain from public displays of affection toward their boyfriend/girlfriend or significant other during the Fair week and while participating at any Fair function throughout the year. If any Fair Queen/King Candidate is found to have engaged in any immoral or indecent acts, the Fair Queen/King Candidates may be found ineligible.

-Contestants must attend all practices, pre-pageant events and rehearsals unless excused, in advance by the Pageant Director.

-Hair, make-up and all attire for the pageant and talent portion should be age appropriate.

-Any official reports of misconduct or unsportsmanlike behavior of a contestant or parent may result in disqualification.

-The newly selected Miss Lee County Fair Queen/King and all the winning courts will serve alongside the Junior, Little, Mini & Tiny Queens/Kings. All newly selected 2026 Courts are required to attend the Lee County Fair 2026, distributing ribbons and other duties designated by the Pageant Director or any member of the Fair Board. Queens/Kings must be available the whole weekend to assist.

-Attendance at local and surrounding parades is highly encouraged at the approval of the pageant director. It is the responsibility of the Lee County parent/guardian to provide all transportation to and from any event, and during the event.

-The contestant will not be officially entered in the Lee County Fair Royalty Pageant until the finished application is submitted to the Pageant Director. The finished application must be submitted by the deadline. In the event of a natural disaster or other unavoidable events, the Lee County Fair Royalty Pageant Committee may change the dates and times of the contest, parade, coronation, and other activities associated with the Lee County Fair Royalty Scholarship Contest.

-It is the responsibility of the Fair Queen/King Candidate to provide the Pageant Committee with at least 1 valid telephone number, a mailing address, and appropriate email addresses at which they can be reached, as well as valid contact information for the Fair Queen/King's legal guardian. It is the responsibility of the Fair Queen/King to remain in contact with the Director in charge to obtain any changes in locations, obligations, dates, times, and rules.

-Fair Queen/King winners will be issued a sash and crown at the coronation and will be responsible if the items, if they are lost or damaged the items must be replaced at the Queen/Kings expense.

-The Fair Queen/King Candidate selected as Fair Queen/King must sign a contract with the Lee County Fair Royalty Committee immediately following coronation.

-The Lee County Fair Queen/King will serve a term of one year as an ambassador of the Lee County Fair. The Fair Queen/King is also expected to attend other Fair-sponsored events throughout the year, a list of which will be provided. The Fair Queen/King will also serve on the Lee County Fair Association Royalty Committee for the following year.

The Tiny, Mini, Little, Junior and Miss/Mr Lee County Fair Royalty Pageant are for the contestants and new queen/King and their court. All parents or guardians (referred to hereby as parent) associated with the Tiny, Mini, Little, Junior and Miss/Mr Lee County Fair Pageant welcomes you to share in the pleasure of watching your child participate as long as behavior does not distract the contestants, Lee County Fair Board, Pageant Director, pageant crew and/or the judges. Any issues a parent may have with any of the above mentioned persons should be submitted in writing to the Lee County Fair Association office and addressed as a proper time and place.

The Parent Should:

- Make no remarks to the Lee County Fair Board, the Pageant Directors, pageant crew, judges or spectator's unless intended to convey a genuine interest, friendship or encouragement.
- Avoid sharp remarks directed to contestants who make mistakes during the Tiny, Petite, Little, Junior and Miss/Mr Lee County Fair Pageant.
- Support the Lee County Fair Board, Pageant Directors, pageant crew and judges consistently regardless of the result of the competition. The Lee County Fair Board, Pageant Director, pageant crew and judges contribute many hours of their time to your son/daughter.

The Parent Must:

- Never use foul language or obscene gestures at pageant events related to and including the Tiny, Mini, Little, Junior and Miss/Mr Lee County Fair Royalty Pageant.
- Avoid persistent comments and gestures which express discouragement with the judge's final decisions.
- Cooperation immediately with any request by the Lee County Fair Board, and the Pageant Directors, or pageant crew.

Any parent who fails to adhere to these standards can and will be asked to leave and will run the risk of their son/daughter being disqualified from obtaining the title of Tiny, Mini, Little, Junior and Miss/Mr Lee County Fair Queen.
